The City of Alexandria is initiating public engagement in March and April regarding an "open space zoning" amendment. Per the City's website, the amendment is an initiative included within the Open Space Policy Plan process to address the City's Open Space needs. The amendment supports the City Council 2022 Community Priority to Support Youth and Families by expanding the City's ability to implement community-based plan recommendations, and the City's goal of providing safe and equitable access to facilities and services.
