<u>Duke Street In Motion</u> is holding a third round of public engagement through Sunday, April 30 to share findings from technical analysis and collect <u>feedback</u> on two updated concepts for the Duke Street corridor.

Thanks to those who attended the open house on Thursday, April 20 at Bishop Ireton! **Please review** <u>engagement materials</u> **and complete the** <u>feedback form</u> **by Sunday, April 30** to share your thoughts on the redesign of Duke Street!

All feedback will be posted on the <u>project website</u> and shared with the Duke Street In Motion Advisory Group, which will be making a recommendation to Council on <u>May 25</u> on a preferred concept for the busway for each segment of the corridor as well as on curb features such as sidewalks, shared use paths, and bicycling facilities. Council is slated to consider the recommendation in June.
