On June 27th, City Council approved the concept design for the Duke Street Transitway as proposed by the Duke Street Advisory Group. The City will continue to work with residents on design elements of the project, specifically some of the service roads and intersections in Segment 3, later this summer. Seminary Hill Civic Association (SHA) Updates:

ACPS District B Board Members – Kelly Booz and Ashley Baird Simpson – attended the June 8, 2023 SHA meeting at Immanuel Church on the Hill and answered a variety of questions about Douglas MacArthur and Minnie Howard plans. SHA is not meeting this summer and will reconvene September 21, 2023.

• **Douglas MacArthur Modernization Project:** Installation of the scoreboard and climbing wall in the gymnasium are complete. Level two cabinets and wainscotting are complete, installation is

ongoing on remaining levels. Traffic coating in the garage has begun and will continue over the next few weeks. Installation of cafeteria flooring and kitchen equipment is ongoing. Bus loop grading and paving are complete. Installation of kitchen flooring, the gymnasium kalwall and the learning stair curtain wall are also complete. Restroom tile is complete on level three and fixture installation is ongoing on levels one and three. Metal panel installation along the exterior is nearing completion. Curb and sidewalk work continues in multiple areas.

Alexandria Federation of Civic Associations (AFCA) Updates:

AFCA met on June 28, 2023. Josh Baker, CEO, Alexandria Transit Company (DASH), followed by Kathie Hoekstra, Chair, Alexandria Environmental Protection Commission opened the program. AFCA is planning a Housing Forum in the September/October timeframe.

Stephens & St. Agnes School (SSSAS) Updates:

SSSAS's construction project is underway. The module classrooms are up and will be ready for the start of the school year in September. If the construction trucks are not exiting down St. Stephens Rd. onto Seminary Rd., please let SSSAS know because that's the route they're supposed to take. They'll be running 30-40 trucks down the road every day to get as much work done as they can over the summer. Building will start in September. SSSAS has asked the trucks not to come through during school drop-off and pick-up times so the truck traffic shouldn't interfere with parent/student traffic. The plan is for the modular buildings to be up all school year. If the work is completed on time, the modular buildings will be taken down at the end of the school year; if there are any delays, they'll be kept up through Summer 2024.
